Beginner Rider Ages 6 & Up

Participants learn how to work safely around horses while grooming, saddling, and handling their faithful assigned mount. Students can expect to accomplish steering, turning and trotting on their own by the end of the session. Mondays' 4:30-5:30PM

Beginner Intermediate Rider Ages 6 & Up

Continue to learn with more challenging horsemanship lessons. Lessons are structured to improve position at the walk and trot and work on patterns to prepare the student for beginner jumping.

- D. March 7,14,21,28 April 4,11

Intermediate Rider Ages 6 & Up

Students learn more advanced horsemanship with a focus on jumping, balance and control.

Wednesdays' 5:30-6:30PM

- F. March 7,14,21,28 April 4,11

The series consist of 6 lessons which last 1 hour in length.
